



AHW Releases 2017 Annual Report, Highlights Year of Changemaking Statewide



AHW invites you to review our 2017 annual report, now posted online. The report highlights a year of changemaking in action, providing an overview of the ways in which AHW is investing, connecting, and influencing factors that can positively impact health statewide.

Over the past fiscal year, AHW invested \$2.3 million in seven community-led initiatives while also furthering our \$20 million, eight-year commitment to behavioral health projects statewide through the award of an additional \$12.7 million to 10 coalitions and an MCW partner team in our Advancing Behavioral Health initiative. The awards in this fiscal year also include \$280,000 in 12 capacity-building projects that engaged more than 130 partners in opportunities for technical assistance and learning. In research and education, AHW awarded \$10.7 million to 10 projects advancing discovery and innovations through research pathways and workforce and academic development.
