AHW was selected by the Collective Impact Forum, a national network supporting and accelerating collective impact approaches, to highlight its innovative philanthropic model in a webinar held on Nov. 21.

The “Funding the Long Game in Collective Impact” [recorded webinar](#) is now available online, and showcases AHW’s [Advancing Behavioral Health Initiative](#), an eight-year, \$20 million commitment to improve mental and behavioral health outcomes in 10 Wisconsin communities, as a “promising new model” for achieving collective impact.

The Advancing Behavioral Health Initiative takes a new, strategic approach that combines a substantial funding period with extensive technical and capacity-building support to enable each of the 10 communities, and one MCW academic partner team, to develop stronger strategies for addressing community need, put those strategies into action, and then evaluate their impact.
