She is currently a fellow in the American College of Surgeons, was recently elected director-at-large of the Surgical Outcomes Club, serves as a councilor in the Association for Academic Surgery, and is a member of the Society of Black Academic Surgeons, Society of Surgical Oncology, and Association of Women Surgeons.

Dr. Maduekwe earned a Bachelor of Science in molecular and cell biology from the University of Texas at Dallas, her MD and MMSc degrees from Harvard Medical School, and MPH from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. She completed her general surgery residency at Massachusetts General Hospital (Boston, Mass.) followed by a complex general surgical oncology fellowship at the University of Pittsburgh Medical Center. She is board certified in general surgery and complex general surgical oncology.
